Feather Lace Shawl

This lovely lace shoulder shawl is designed to make the most of your fingering-weight yarn. Simply knit until you're nearly out of yarn, then bind off! The shawl pictured was made from a single skein of Sea Silk. This pattern also works great with gently variegated sock yarn.

materials

- fingering-weight yarn, at least 450 yds
- 24"-36" size 3 (3.25mm) circular needle
- yarn needle
- stitch markers

Sample uses Handmaiden Sea Silk in Pumpkin.

gauge

approx 28 sts/32 rows = 4" in st st (gauge is not critical for this project)

difficulty

Finished Size: 40" x 21" after blocking
