


Gardiner Yarn Works

Hood River Top-Down Mitts

Love fingerless mitts but hate having leftover yarn when you're done? Knit them top-down and keep going until every last bit is used up!

materials

- worsted-weight yarn, approx 110 yds for wrist-length mitts or up to 250 yds for opera-length mitts
- set of 5 size 6 (4mm)

double-pointed needles and/or set of two size 6 (4mm) circular needles or size to obtain gauge

- yarn needle
- stitch markers

Samples use Malabrigo Silky Merino in Wisteria (long mitt) and Cascade 220 Superwash in color# 858 (short mitt).

gauge

20 sts/30 rnds = 4" in st st

difficulty

easy

sizes

Sized for M/L

Hand Circumference: 8.5"

Note: The ribbed pattern is quite stretchy and will fit a wide range of hands both smaller and larger.
