Hurricane Socks

Designed by Chrissy Gardiner to benefit the Red Cross Disaster Relief Fund



Survive the rainy season by challenging yourself to knit this stranded colorwork sock with a pattern that mimics the symbols found on a weathermap. Contrasting heel is worked using short rows.

materials

 fingering-weight yarn, approx 300 yds each of main color (MC) and contrasting color (CC)

- set of 5 size 1 (2.5mm) double-pointed needles or set of 2 size 1 (2.5mm) 24" circular needles or size to obtain gauge
- yarn needle

Pictured sample uses Cascade Heritage in colors #5615 (MC) and #5618 (CC).

32 sts/40 rnds = 4" in colorwork pattern
