Cabled Baglet Errata

Here are the correct instructions for the Celtic Braid (including abbreviations) used in the Cabled Baglet pattern published in 101 Designer One-Skein Wonders. Storey appears to have taken down their correction. This error was introduced during the editing of the pattern, which I had no control over. I wasn't given a chance to review the changes before the book went to print, and I apologize profusely for any inconvenience.

Stitch Patterns

C4F: Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k2, k2 from cable needle.

C4B: Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k2, k2 from cable needle.

T3F: Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, p1, k2 from cable needle.

T3B: Slip 1 st to cable needle and hold in back, k2, p1 from cable needle.

T4F: Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, p2, k2 from cable needle.

T4B: Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k2, p2 from cable needle.

Celtic Braid Panel (over 26 sts and 16 rnds):

Rnd 1: P3, C4B, (p4, C4B) 2x, p3.

Rnd 2 (and all even # rnds): Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts as established in the previous rnd.

Rnd 3: P2, T3B, (T4F, T4B) 2x, T3F, p2.

Rnd 5: P1, T3B, p3, C4F, p4, C4F, p3, T3F, p1.

Rnd 7: P1, k2, p3, T3B, T4F, T4B, T3F, p3, k2, p1.

Rnd 9: P1, (k2, p3) 2x, C4B, (p3, k2) 2x, p1.

Rnd 11: P1, k2, p3, T3F, T4B, T4F, T3B, p3, k2, p1.

Rnd 13: P1, T3F, p3, C4F, p4, C4F, p3, T3B, p1.

Rnd 15: P2, T3F, (T4B, T4F) 2x, T3B, p2.
