### abbreviations

approx = approximately  
beg = begin(ning)  
CO = cast on  
cont = continue(ing)  
dpn(s) = double-pointed needle(s)  
estab = establish(ed)  
k = knit  
k2tog = knit 2 sts together  
ndl(s) = needle(s)  
p = purl  
p2tog = purl 2 sts together  
pat(s) = pattern(s)  
pm = place marker  
pu = pick up and knit  
rep(s) = repeat(s)  
rnd(s) = round(s)  
RS = right side  
sl = slip stitch as if to purl  
S2KP = slip 2 sts together as if to knit, k1, pass 2 slipped sts over  
SSK = slip 2 sts one at a time as if to knit, insert left needle tip into the front of the two sts and knit them together  
st(s) = stitch(es)  
st st = stockinette stitch  
WS = wrong side  
x = times  
YO = yarn over

Join sts without twisting and work Ribbing Rnds 1-10 over all sts.

**Ribbing Rnds 1-10:** \*K2, p2, k2, p1, k2, p2; rep from \* to end of rnd.

Work Trident Lace pat from chart or written instructions on p3 over all sts. End with Rnd 6 when leg measures approx 6" from top (or desired length to top of heel flap).
